FROM 1990 – 2005, MISSOURI SPENT AN ESTIMATED \$5.2 BILLION ON CORPORATE SUBSIDIES.¹

DESPITE BILLIONS SPENT ON INCENTIVES, MISSOURI STILL RANKS 49TH AMONG ALL STATES FOR ECONOMIC GROWTH.²

Tax credits and corporate subsidies aren't working. Ending corporate handouts will save our state hundreds of millions of dollars every year.

Senate Bill 285: Reduces the corporate income tax gradually and reduces or eliminates certain tax credit programs.

House Bill 718: Creates the “Corporate Welfare Elimination Act” which would place a sunset on every corporate tax credit program.
